"Fax-Bax"—Bank, an English artists' collective, presents the results of a public-service project: they faxed galleries back their own press releases, with comments and an overall grade (one reads, "Overly verbose; full of overblown claims and exhausting hyperbolic sales pitch"; another, "Incomplete sentence! Always read over what you've written"). They also painted some completely extraneous watercolors on top of their edited releases, none of which manage to obscure the passages of richly deserved snideness they have penned in the margin.
