rupert goldsworthy gallery is pleased to present a group exhibition featuring paintings by **Christopher Brooks, Astrid Küver** and **Susi Pop**.

The opening reception is on Saturday November 21st from 6-8pm. The show runs from November 14th to Dec 17th, 2009.

All three artists in this exhibition work predominantly in the medium of painting.

Christopher Brooks is a British artist based in New York whose work references graffiti art, gestural abstraction, Pop art, popular signage, and funk art. **Brooks'** work incorporates collage, stickers, cartoons, porn, and signs from contemporary car culture. **Brooks** will exhibit a new series of medium- and small-sized works on masonite.

Astrid Küver is a Berlin-based figurative painter who works in oil on canvas. For this exhibition **Küver** will show paintings from two recent series which relate to domestic and social life in West Germany during the Wirtschaftswunder (the post-war West German economic miracle).

Susi Pop is the label taken by an anonymous group of Berlin-based artists who work primarily in painting, silkscreen and sculpture. A predominant characteristic in the **Susi Pop** oeuvre is the color magenta. **Susi Pop's** work references historical painting, modernist abstraction and Pop art. Two different bodies of work will be exhibited: A brand new series of screenprints-on-canvas of surveillance cameras, and also paintings from the late 1980s which reproduce statistics from financial journalism documenting the American economic crash of that era.
